


We are a non-profit organization established in 2012. Our mission is to serve Houston's at-risk children by providing them with books to build their own home libraries.

More than 90,000 of Houston ISD's elementary-aged children live at or below the poverty line. For families in these situations, books are considered a luxury. Research has shown that children growing up in homes without books are less likely to complete a basic education than their peers who do have books at home.

Books Between Kids collects gently-used books from the community throughout the school year. The donated books are sorted, inventoried and boxed by volunteers in our warehouse. Each May, the books are delivered to selected Houston ISD schools that then hold a Book Celebration for each child in the school to choose 6 books apiece. These books are for the children to take home and keep for their own.
